A Year in Review

In February, we spent time looking back on our first year. To begin, we listened to the song "Caminante no hay camino" ("Wayfarer, there is no path") and walked around the room looking at visual representations of the road we had forged over the past year. Displays included artistic renderings of our names, drafts of our mission statement, and a diagram of where we hope to fit in to the structure of L'Arche GWDC.

We then introduced a systemic perspective on diversity by talking about systems we experience in all parts of our lives: organ systems, the solar system, being part of a church or education system. We learned that some systems create repeated, cumulative advantages for some people and disadvantages for others. We then talked about some privileges we experience and others that we may not experience.

Finally, we talked about our goals for the next year. We have been asked to submit a proposal to become a commission, and since February have re-written our primary goal to read: "Communicate internally our (refers to all people of L'Arche GWDC) vision for diversity at L'Arche GWDC" with further objectives and strategies.

Current Work:

Since our last meeting, Caitlin and Yuko have spent time breaking down our primary goal into more specific objectives and strategies. We are very excited to share those with you and to begin working through the strategies! During our May meeting we will break into a new set of working groups and will continue discernment of a new co-leader. We are also looking forward to sending prayers to L'Arche USA's new Diversity Team (led by Maria Guzman of L'Arche Atlanta and including members from L'Arche GWDC).
