Lifelong Care and Relationships

Someone working for disability services in D.C. once asked why core members in L'Arche stay so long, as compared to residents in other service providers often choosing to leave. Our answer? Lifelong care and relationships. Deep care and faithful relationships don't just happen—they take work, dedication, and commitment. Gratefully, your donations allow us to make that work a priority.

- ♥ Your support helps us respond to the changing and divergent needs within our community, which is both aging and young. We support core members in their retirement and in seeking competitive employment (Kelly got that job at Jake's Ice Cream she wanted!). We welcomed more assistants so core members can consistently engage in the activities they wish. We leased an accessible van and hailed many accessible taxis. From food processors for specialty diets to stocking our pantry with someone's comfort food, your support enables core members to live their lives how they choose.
- ♥ Although much of our world has gone back to normal, our homes continue following government protocols that require seasons of COVID isolation and quarantine. During these times many friends and neighbors dropped off dinners, which was a huge support to our homes.
- ♥ Our Medicaid contracts typically do not cover expenses related to things like exercise classes, specialty therapies, staffing during hospital stays, bonuses for the extraordinary work of our assistants, or high-quality employee health care. Your generosity helped core members and employees experience meaningful care and support above and beyond government funding.

Education and Advocacy

An important part of our mission is building a more human society, one that welcomes and learns from people with disabilities. We lived out this part of our mission in several ways, made possible by your support.



GWDC's Diversity Commission hosted Black History Month Zoom talks. Joseph started us off strong with a talk on Marvin Gaye and his impact on music. The Diversity Commission also led our first annual cultural humility training for all employees.



Our Inclusion Party Team was invited by L'Arche USA to lead a session on inclusive team building through play.



We presented our film: "My Voice: Amplifying the Voices of People with Intellectual Disabilities in the Medical System" to hundreds of students and medical professionals across the country.



We hosted our Diving Deeper series online, discussing human-centered healthcare, making a living with a disability, and the spirituality of L'Arche.



Mission of Transformation

In L'Arche, mutual transformation is a way of life, allowing ourselves to grow together and be changed. Here are a few ways we lived out our mission of transformation this past year:

Donations continue making spaces of transformation possible: prayer nights continued monthly, we hosted Lent and Advent retreats for the broader community, formations on faith and mission occurred regularly, and birthday, anniversary, welcome, and farewell celebrations remained a constant of community life.

As an international federation, we finished drafting L'Arche's Charter, to be voted on for approval at the June 2023 International Assembly. This process began in 2019 and gave space for members of L'Arche around the world to share what L'Arche means to them and express all that unites us.

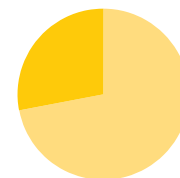

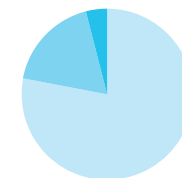

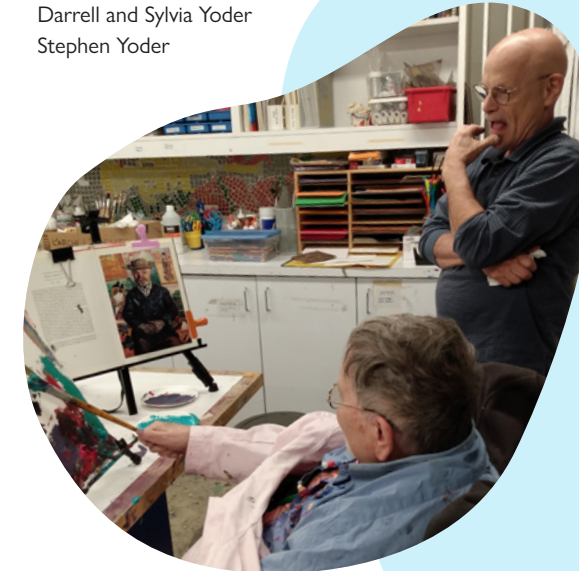
